

Rules of the Club

Etiquette & Dress Code

- > Please treat the Clubhouse and Courts with respect.
- > The Clubhouse and courts should be left in a clean and tidy condition.
- > Members waiting to play should remain outside the court whilst play is in progress.
- > The Clubhouse is a NO SMOKING area.
- > Please leave the kitchen area clean and tidy with cups washed up after use.
- > Players should dress in recognised Tennis or sporting clothing.
- Tennis shoes must be worn by all members on court, including Juniors. Heeled, black soled shoes, boots or muddy trainers are not permitted as they damage the courts.
- > The last person leaving the court is responsible for locking the gates and turning out the lights.
- If the Clubhouse is not open, the disabled toilet is accessible from the outside using the key found in the lock box next to the Clubhouse door. The code for the lockbox is on the Club Joining Information sheet sent to all new members when they sign up.
- Parents are expected to accept responsibility for the behaviour of, and any damage caused by, junior members.

Court Bookings

- Courts may be booked for a maximum of 1 ½ hours at a time (other than for matches or tournaments).
- If a court booked is not in use 10 minutes after the commencement of the booking time, rights to the court are lost and it is available for use by another member.
- > Members must use the court they have booked or delete the booking.
- Courts may be booked 1 WEEK IN ADVANCE using the ClubSpark booking website.
- Adult members only may book Peak Time in advance. (Peak Times are 1800 2200 Monday to Friday and any time on Saturday and Sunday) Juniors may book available peak time courts on the day but not before.

<u>Guests</u>

- > No person may be introduced as a playing guest on more than 6 occasions in any year.
- > Members shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests whilst on the Club premises.
- > Parents of Junior members are not permitted to hit with their children unless they are members.

Club Access

All access gates to the courts are secured with passcode padlocks. The passcode is emailed to all to new members on receipt of their membership forms and subscription. Passcodes are changed every 3 months and members will be emailed to advise of the new code accordingly.

Keys to the Clubhouse are available on request to a committee member at a cost price of £10, refundable when no longer required.
